Kindly note the material included in the First English Assessment which will be on **Sunday , Oct- 5th.**

(Students have to study the book, the booklet, notebooks, comprehension sheets, vocabulary sheets, quizzes and any other sheet related to the material)

I. Literature:

1. Taking Care of the Young (Student's Edition pages 12-15) + booklet p.7+8+9
2. Students should know the genre of the text(**Informational text**) and please note that it must be spelled correctly.
3. Students will be asked to answer questions on a given paragraph like:
Describe, explain, find a word that means and direct questions. Also, they will be asked to find out a pronoun reference.
4. Students should study comprehension sheets related to the story.

II. Unseen passage

Students will be asked to answer questions on a given passage like:

Describe, explain, and direct questions.

(The passage in the booklet is an example and students will be given a **different** passage in the exam)

III. Grammar:

Simple Present Be and Regular Verbs (Student's Edition p. 24 & 25. Booklet p.(11-15).

- Students should write sentences using simple present.
- Change affirmative simple present sentences into negative & vice versa.
- Make questions using simple present tense.
- Students will be asked to find simple present verbs from a given text.
- Students will be asked to use correct simple present verbs to complete sentences.

IV. Vocabulary
