#### I. Literature:

- 2. Students should know the genre of the text( Informational text) and please note that it must be spelled correctly.
- 3. Students will be asked to answer questions on a given paragraph like:

- Make questions using simple present tense.
- Students will be asked to find simple present verbs from a given text.
