9.	significant (adjective)	important or noticeable the <u>noun</u> is <i>significance</i> .	- I've noticed a <u>significant</u> improvement in her work in the last month.

10. technology (noun)	all the knowledge and equipment used in science	- New kinds of <u>technology</u> will be invented in the future.	
11. ice skating	wearing shoes with sharp blades attached to move smoothly on ice	- We enjoyed <u>ice skating</u> on the frozen pond.	
12. general anesthesia	placing patients in a sleeplike state during surgery	- The dentist used <u>general anesthesia</u> to make sure the patient felt no pain during the tooth extraction.
