archaeologist	A person who studies the past by digging up old things.	Noun	The archaeologist found an old pot in the ground.
clues	Small signs or things that help us find an answer.	Noun (plural)	The broken wall gave clues about the old building.
disappeared	Gone; not seen anymore.	Verb (past tense)	The city disappeared after the big flood.
sacred	Very special or holy.	Adjective	The temple was a sacred place for the people.
architecture	The way buildings are planned and built.	Noun	The architecture of the pyramid is amazing.
evidence	Proof that shows something is true.	Noun	The stone tools were evidence of how people lived.
motive	A reason for doing something.	Noun	The archaeologist's motive was to learn about history.
artifacts	Old objects made by people long ago.	Noun (plural)	We saw artifacts like jewelry and tools in the museum.
