tradition	A custom or belief passed down from generation to generation	noun	It is a family tradition to have dinner together every Sunday.	custom, practice, ritual	traditional (adj)
skywrite	To write a message in the sky, usually using an airplane	verb	The pilot will skywrite "Happy Birthday" above the city.	—	skywriting (noun)
damage	Physical harm that reduces value, usefulness, or function	noun	The storm caused severe damage to the roof.	harm, destruction, injury	damage (verb) – "The storm damaged the roof."
mechanic	A person who repairs and maintains machines or engines	noun	The mechanic fixed the car's engine.	technician, engineer (informal)	—
cottage	A small, cozy house, often in the countryside	noun	They spent the weekend in a quiet cottage by the lake.	cabin, house, hut	—
charge	To demand payment or to power something (depending on context)	verb/noun	The store charges \$10 for delivery. / Please charge your phone.	fee, power, bill	charge (noun), charging (verb/adj)
carry	To hold or move something from one place to another	verb	She can carry the box upstairs by herself.	transport, lift, bear	carrier (noun)
