Tsunami	Noun	A huge ocean wave caused by an underwater disturbance, like an earthquake.	The tsunami destroyed many houses near the beach.	tidal wave, sea wave
Damage	Noun / Verb	Harm or injury that makes something less useful or valuable.	The storm caused a lot of damage to the village.	harm, destruction, ruin
Gigantic	Adjective	Extremely large in size.	A gigantic wave hit the shore.	huge, enormous, massive
Impact	Noun	A strong effect or influence on something.	The earthquake had a big impact on the city.	effect, influence, result
Intruder	Noun	Someone or something that enters a place without permission.	The tsunami was like an intruder in the town.	invader, trespasser, outsider
Period	Noun	A length of time.	The period of heavy rain lasted three days.	duration, time, phase
After	Preposition/Adverb/Conjunction	Coming later in time than something else.	Life changed after the flood.	following, later, next
