| related | connected by family or ideas | adj. | <i>We are not related, but we are close friends.</i> | connected, linked | relation (n.), relate (v.) |
| similar | almost the same | adj. | <i>Her handwriting is similar to mine.</i> | alike, comparable | similarity (n.) |
| attach | to join or fasten to something | v. | <i>Please attach the file to the email.</i> | connect, fix | attachment (n.) |
| clever | quick to understand, smart | adj. | <i>He is a clever student who solves problems fast.</i> | smart, intelligent | cleverly (adv.), cleverness (n.) |
| pretended | acted as if something was true | v. (past) | <i>He pretended to be sick to skip school.</i> | faked, acted | pretend (v.), pretending (adj.) |
| eager | very excited or willing | adj. | <i>She is eager to learn new skills.</i> | enthusiastic, keen | eagerly (adv.), eagerness (n.) |
