traits	Special qualities or characteristics of a person or thing	Noun (plural)	Honesty and kindness are good traits.	qualities, features, characteristics	<i>trait</i> (singular noun)
illegal	Not allowed by law or rules	Adjective	It is illegal to drive without a license.	unlawful, forbidden, banned	<i>illegally</i> (adv), <i>illegality</i> (noun)
