Ancient	Adjective	Very old, from a long time ago	old, historic	The pyramids are ancient buildings in Egypt.
Ceremony	Noun	A special event or activity	event, celebration	We had a school ceremony to honor the winners.
Citizen	Noun	A person who belongs to a country	resident, member	Every citizen has the duty to follow the law.
Rituals	Noun (plural)	Actions done in a special way, often for tradition or religion	customs, traditions	The ancient Egyptians had special rituals for burials.
Rights	Noun (plural)	Things people are allowed to have or do	freedoms, privileges	Children have the right to go to school.
Philosophy	Noun	A way of thinking about life	belief, idea	His philosophy is to always be kind.
Cultural	Adjective	Related to traditions and lifestyle of people	traditional, heritage	Music is an important cultural activity.
Education	Noun	Learning from school or experience	learning, teaching	Good education helps people build a better future.
