Students will be asked to choose the suitable meaning of words based on the context. Only practice the form of the question but **NO** need to memorize the words and their meanings in these pages.

Grammar: Singular and Plural Nouns:

Student's Book: pages. (52-53)

English booklet: pages. (23+24) + extra grammar worksheet (Articles

a/an/the)

A <u>singular noun</u> names one person, place or thing.

A plural noun names two or more people, places, or things.

- 1. For most nouns, add -s.
- 2. For nouns ending in -s, -ch, -sh, or -x, add -es.
- 3. For nouns ending in a consonant + -y, change -y into -i and add -es.
- 4. For nouns ending in a vowel + -y, only add -s.
- 5. Use the to refer to specific things.
- 6. Use a/an to refer to singular things that aren't specific (any thing and not a specific thing).

Reading Comprehension: Story "My Family":

Student's Book: pages. (42-47) English booklet pages. (20+21+22)

Students should read the text "My Family" and answer questions about the following points in addition to other comprehension questions about the story.

- 1. Genre: Personal Narrative. (Student should be able to write it correctly).
- 2. <u>Author</u>: Hanna Jamal
- 3. <u>Illustrator</u>: Kathryn Mitter
- 4. **Characters**: the girl and her family, in addition to friends and neighbors.

Students will be provided with an *unseen passage* and they will answer comprehension questions related to the text.

Writing: Describe a Family Celebration:

(The test will be on Thursday 30/10/2025 during the English classes)

Student's Book: pages. (54+55) English booklet: pages. (25+26)

Students will be asked to write a paragraph <u>describing one of the suggested</u> family celebrations given in the test.

Study this section using the Writing Notebook and the Booklet.

You are not allowed to memorize any paragraph or write out of context in the test.

*Here is the outline:

- 1. Think of a family celebration you celebrate with your family; birthday, graduation, wedding, holiday, Eid, Ramadan or any other celebration.
- 2. Tell who is at the celebration.
- 3. Tell what does everyone do to prepare for the celebration and What happens
- 4. A word bank will be given to help in writing.
- 5. You should use simple present be verbs.
