will will not (won't)	to show <b>certainty</b>	I will visit my friend this weekend.
going to	to talk about <b>future plans</b>	I am <b>going to</b> read a book.
shall	to <b>offer</b> or <b>suggest</b>	Shall we go to the park?
might could	to show <b>possibility</b> (to say maybe)	I might bring cupcakes to the party. We <b>could</b> go out if it stops raining.
