Word	Definition	Part of Speech	Synonyms	Example Sentence
Migrate	To move from one place to another, usually to live or work there	Verb	move, relocate, travel	Many birds migrate to warmer countries in winter.
Primary	Most important; first in order or rank	Adjective	main, chief, basic	Education is the primary responsibility of the school.
Refugee	A person who leaves their country to escape war, danger, or persecution	Noun	displaced person, asylum seeker	The refugee left his country to find safety.
Overwhelmed	Feeling unable to cope because something is too much	Adjective	stressed, overloaded, exhausted	She felt overwhelmed by too much homework.
Contribute	To give or add something to help achieve a result	Verb	help, donate, add	Everyone should contribute ideas during the discussion.
Poverty	The state of being very poor	Noun	hardship, need, deprivation	Poverty affects many families around the world.
Enabled	Made possible; given the ability or power to do something	Verb (past) / Adjective	allowed, empowered, helped	The program enabled students to improve their skills.
Flee	To run away from danger or a bad situation	Verb	escape, run away, avoid	The family had to flee the city because of the war.
