Genre	A type or category of movie, book, or music	Noun	category, type, style	Comedy is my favorite movie genre.
Memorable	Easy to remember or worth remembering	Adjective	unforgettable, striking	The ending of the movie was memorable.
Predictable	Easy to guess what will happen	Adjective	expected, obvious	The plot was predictable from the beginning.
Cliché / Clichéd	Overused and lacking originality	Noun / Adjective	overused idea, stereotype	The movie was clichéd, with the same old love story.
Propaganda	Information used to promote a political or social idea	Noun	persuasion, promotion	The film was criticized for being propaganda.
Critique	A detailed opinion that analyzes strengths and weaknesses	Noun / Verb	review, evaluation	She wrote a critique of the movie's message.
Narrative	The way a story is told or structured	Noun	storyline, plot	The narrative switches between the past and present.
Perspective	A particular point of view	Noun	viewpoint, angle	The story is told from the child's perspective.
