Time: 1 minute speech

Reminder: Your speech should be organized, clear, and easy to follow.

Use these helpful vocabulary words we discussed in class in your speech:

1. Poachers – people who hunt or catch animals illegally.

Sentence: Poachers hurt wild animals by taking them from their homes.

2. Adopt – to take care of an animal or pet as your own.

Sentence: We can adopt animals from shelters to give them a safe home.

3. Endangered – animals that are in danger of disappearing.

Sentence: Tigers are endangered because people cut down their forests.

4. Volunteers – people who help without getting paid.

Sentence: Volunteers work in animal shelters to care for sick animals.

5. Extinct – when no animals of that kind are alive anymore.

Sentence: Dinosaurs are extinct because they all died long ago.
